

### State Park Rustic Cabins

Michigan State Parks have more than 60 cabins available to rent. Over a dozen different parks have cabins for your convenience and pleasure. These rustic cabins can be a functional and enjoyable base camp for hunting, fishing or hiking. Cross-country skiing, ice fishing or snowmobiling can be just as much fun.

The cabins are on quiet sites and many overlook water. The smaller cabins tend to be more comfortable for families. At some sites two or more nearby cabins can accommodate larger groups.

The cabins have single size beds or bunks with mattresses, a table, chairs, broom and wood or propane stove for heat. Firewood is provided only for cabin heat. There are outside hand-pumps for water and vault toilets.

You must bring bedding, cookware and tableware, axe and handsaw, first-aid kit, lanterns, flashlights, and bug repellent. We recommend a portable stove for cooking.

**NOTE: Porcupine Mountains'** cabins are accessible by backpacking from one to four miles. They do not have hand-pumps for water or firewood for heat. Besides the bunks with mattresses, the cabins have cookware, tableware, axe and saw.

**Highland's Bass Lake Cabin** is equipped with an indoor restroom with shower, kitchen facilities including electric stove and refrigerator, and a gas furnace.

**Holly's** cabin is equipped with lights and electricity.

### Reservations

- Call or visit the park and ask if suitable cabins and dates are available for your visit.
- If you make a reservation by phone, send the total fee to the park. We accept checks, money orders, Visa, and MasterCard.
- To reserve by mail, send completed application to the park with the total fee. It is your responsibility to call the park and confirm your reservation.

### Cancellations/Refunds

If you can't use your reservation, notify the appropriate park office. If requested 15 days or more prior to arrival, a full refund of paid camp nights, less the reservation fee, will be given. The reservation fee will only be refunded if the park must initiate the reservation cancellation due to unforeseen circumstances, such as a natural disaster. If requested less than 15 days prior to arrival, the reservation fee and the first night's camping fee or half the total camping fee (whichever is greater) is forfeited unless the park cannot fulfill the reservation contract. If notice of cancellation is received by phone or mail after the first night, but before 1:00 p.m. of the second day of the reservation, a refund will be made for half the balance of the unused time. If you occupy the cabin for a portion of your stay and request an early departure, the park will issue a refund for half the value of the unused nights. A camp night is considered "used" after 1:00 p.m. each day. A refund will not be made for the minimum rental period of 2 nights if the reservation was made under those conditions.

## Long Range Reservations

You may reserve cabins now for any date next year. Applications will be acted upon after January 1 for the subsequent calendar year, as well as for the current calendar year. (Example: On January 1, 2004, applications will be accepted for the 2005 calendar year also.) Reservations will be on a first come, first serve basis. In the event that multiple reservation requests are received for a given night, a lottery will be used to select the successful occupant. Parks will require a two night minimum rental period for weekends (e.g. no Friday-only or Saturday-only reservations).

## Applicant Requirements and Regulations

- The senior responsible person of the party must register.
- Applicants must be 17 years of age or older.
- Occupancy is limited to the number of beds provided in the cabin.
- Dogs or other pets are not permitted in cabins. The only exception is service dogs (e.g. leader dogs).
- All motor vehicles require a State Park Motor Vehicle Permit.
- Park vehicles in the areas designated.
- Applications to a party limited to no more than 15 nights at any park.
- Cabin occupants are liable for damages to the cabin and its contents.


## Check In/Check Out

Check out time is 1:00 p.m. Check in time may be any time after 3:00 p.m. and is arranged between you and the park. Your cabin will not be held past 1:00 p.m. of your second day unless the park office receives prior notice of your late arrival.

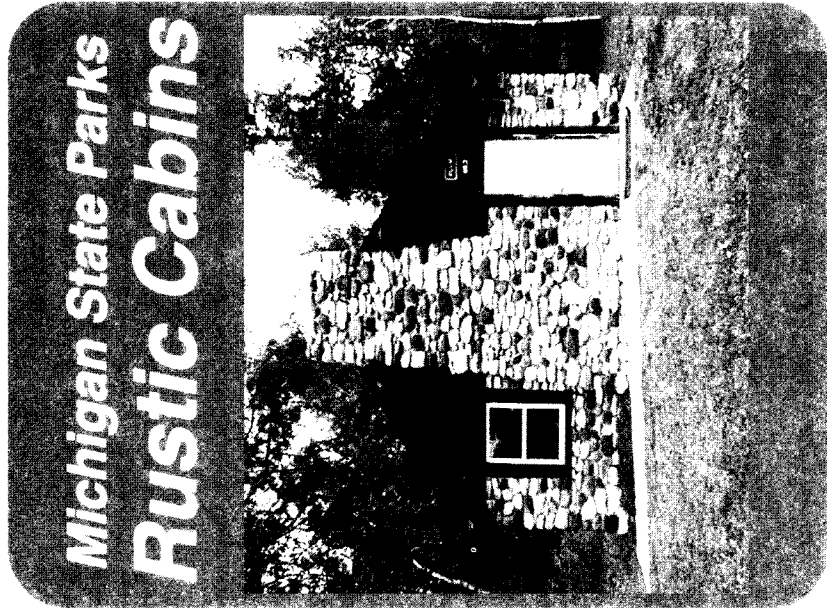
## Cabin Etiquette
