Long Range Reservations

You may reserve cabins now for any date next year. Applications will be acted upon after January 1 for the subsequent calendar year, as well as for the current calendar year. (Example: On January 1, 2004, applications will be accepted for the 2005 calendar year also.) Reservations will be on a first come, first serve basis. In the event that multiple reservation requests are received for a given night. a lottery will be used to select the successful occupant. Parks will require a two night minimum rental period for weekends (e.g. no Friday-only or Saturday-only reservations).

- Applicants must be 17 years of age or older.
- Occupancy is limited to the number of beds provided in the cabin.
- Dogs or other pets are not permitted in cabins. The only exception is service dogs (e.g. leader dogs).
- All motor vehicles require a State Park Motor Vehicle Permit.
- Park vehicles in the areas designated.
- Applications to a party limited to no more than 15 nights at any park.
- Cabin occupants are liable for damages to the cabin and its contents.

Check In/Check Out




Cabin Etiquette
