- Share the Pack Organizational Structure
- Parental Involvement "Because we rely on volunteers to run the pack, all parents need to volunteer to help the pack in some capacity."
- Note Available Positions: "Tonight we need to fill these vacant positions."
- Recruit most needed position first then the second most until all positions (File 44) ZC are filled.
 - 1. Read the position description.

 - 2. Ask for a volunteer. Wait.
 3. If you find a volunteer, have everyone applaud the new leader and ρεών. hand them the leaders guide and an adult application with the position description code filled in already.
 - 4. If you don't: Cheerfully share with them how you got involved and some of the highlights of your experience. "I will lead but I can't do it alone. I need your help. Will you help me?" Then ask for a volunteer.
 - 5. Explain the support system other pack leaders, Program Helps, training, district support. Then ask for a volunteer. Wait
 - 6. Do it for your son "These are precious years for you and your son. Before you know it he'll be grown up. This is one of your best opportunities you'll have to be a part of his life." Then ask for a volunteer. Wait.
 - 7. Do it for your community Being a scout leader is a respected way of participating in the community. Then ask for a volunteer. Wait
 - 8. Ask if anyone has questions about the position: Overcome the objection and point blank ask that person to volunteer. Common objections are: I don't know how, I don't have the time, I don't want to be stuck doing this alone, I can't afford it, I'm not good in front of people. Wait
 - 9. Beg reread the position description and plead for help. Then ask for a volunteer. Wait
 - 10. Demand If we fail to fill this position we may not be able to accept new boys. Then ask for a volunteer.
- Invite all new leaders to a special training at your house.
- Get all new leaders to basic training.
